A free Space Club taster

Up to 20 pupils • KS1 or KS2 • no cost

- A real club session where pupils **build and test** something.
- If they want more and you do too, we set up a **weekly club**, starting at any point in the term.
- Parents book and pay directly, so there is no cost and no admin for the school.
- The school gets **two free places** every term to allocate to children in need.

You give a room. We bring the rest.

A hall or classroom, and a small corner to store materials. That is the whole ask.

Curriculum-aligned

Mapped to KS1 and KS2 science, computing and PSHE, working scientifically, careers awareness and diversity in STEAM.

Safe by default

Trained, DBS-checked Mission Specialists. One tutor to every ten pupils, 1:12 at KS2, club groups capped at 20.

Eight skills, tracked

Problem solving, creativity, planning, leadership, teamwork, listening, speaking and adapting.
